

The Spokesperson of the Committee on Legal Affairs, Justice, and Human Rights made a statement

On Wednesday 9th December 2020, at 15.10 hrs., at Press Room, 1st Floor, Parliament Building, Hon. Mr. Sartra Sripan, Spokesperson of the Committee on Legal Affairs, Justice, and Human Rights, made a statement on the result of the meeting that the committee considered the facts about the rules and guidelines for law enforcement, including the rights on peaceful political rally. They also invited government agencies and related parties, such as, Commissioner General, Commissioner of Metropolitan Police, Chairperson of the National Human Right Commission of Thailand and representatives of the protesters to discuss the mentioned matters. However, as many of them were on missions, thus, could not attend the meeting. The committee decided to call the next meeting on Wednesday 16th December 2020, so as to invite the Prime Minister, agencies and above mentioned persons for discussion. The Committee expects a good cooperation from all agencies to find the solutions for the country and reduce the social conflicts.
