

The Committee on Legal Affairs, Justice, and Human Rights set up a Working Group to study Tackling Casino and Online Gambling Problems

On Thursday 20th August 2020, at 16.00 hrs., at Press room 1st Floor, Parliament Building, Police Captain Arun Sawasdee, Chairman of the Working Group to study tackling casinos problems and online gambling under the Committee on Legal Affairs, Justice and Human Rights made a statement that the Committee on Legal Affairs, Justice and Human Rights set up the working group to study tackling casinos problems and online gambling because the casino and online gambling lead the youths astray and cause damages, and become a danger to society. The working group had set up a framework for studies to solve the problems by pushing for amendments the laws related to gambling and studying the procedure for prosecuting online gambling which in the past could not arrest the offender. Thus, the working group will study these problems and report to the Committee within 90 days and then submit to the House of Representatives.
