Advisor to Speaker of the House of Representatives announced the progress of the submission of a censure motion to open a general debate for voting of no-confidence of the individual ministers

On Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2021, at 16.20 hrs., at the Press Conference Room, 1<sup>st</sup> floor, Parliament Building, Dr. Sukit Attopakorn, Advisor to Speaker of the House of Representatives, announced the progress of the submission of a censure motion, proposed by Hon. Mr. Sompong Amornvivat, Leader of the Opposition in the House of Representatives together with the leaders of the 6 opposition parties and 2 small parties, to open a general debate for voting of no-confidence of the individual ministers, which submitted to H.E. Mr. Chuan Leekpai, Speaker of the House of Representatives along with the list of 208 Members of the House of Representatives, in accordance with the constitution. After verification of the list by the Secretariat of the House of Representatives, they found that 1 signature did not match with the signature given to the office, however, confirmed a real proponent by the signature owner, subsequently. Now, the motion is being on the process of the Office of the Secretariat to present to Mr. Suphachai Phosu, Second Deputy speaker of the House of Representatives, who is in charge of the motion for further consideration.

Therefore, he would like to clarify that the said motion has not yet passed to H.E. Mr. Chuan Leekpai, although he already acknowledged the concerned motion but it needs to follow the procedures. He confirmed that there were no any words of command from H.E. Mr. Chuan Leekpai, Speaker of the House of Representatives.
