On Monday, 5th July 2021, at 15.15 hrs., at the press conference room, 1st floor, Parliament Building Hon. Mr. Jirayu Houngsub and Hon. Ms. Theerarat Samretvanich, Spokesperson of the Ad-hoc Committee on Annual Budget Appropriations Bill B.E. 2565, made the statement concerning the results of the meeting and progress of the Annual Budget Appropriations Bill B.E. 2565 that the Committee's consideration was taken 13 days on, equal to 98 hours, for 3 ministries and 3 funds, equated with 11.1 percent. The aforementioned ministries were Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Commerce and Ministry of Digital Economy and Society.

Today, the meeting discussed about the review framework of the committee which was considerably delayed than the original framework because of the meeting cancellation due to the coronavirus pandemic situation. The Committee deliberated on the meeting time extension from 21.00 hrs. to 22.00 hrs. and have an additional meeting on Saturday so as to complete the budget review and consideration by 23rd July 2021. This will allow the House of Representatives to complete the annual budget consideration by Sunday, 29th August 2021, according to the 105-days time frame in accordance with the Constitution.
